Annual Membership Categories

Student: (\$15). Any student supporting the Alaska Trails mission.

Individual: (\$25). Anyone supporting the Alaska Trails mission.

Family: (\$35). Two or more people living in one household supporting the Alaska Trails mission.

Trail Organization: (\$50. No dues, if reciprocal membership honored). Any club or other organization supporting the Alaska Trails mission.

Agency: (\$250). A local, state, tribal, or federal government entity.

Corporation - Business: (\$250). Any business or corporation supporting the Alaska Trails mission.

Lifetime: (\$750). Any individual who wishes to pay a onetime membership fee for their lifetime.

Patron: Anyone or a business donating more than \$2,000 at one time to Alaska Trails.

Pay as you can: (Any \$ amount accepted). Any individual or group that supports the Alaska Trails mission, but cannot financially meet a specific membership category.
