- > 2011 Ski-Doo Skandic 800 Super Wide Track
 - Pros
 - > Narrow so good for narrow trails
 - > Good visibility
 - Cons
 - > Heavy compared to new machines of similar size
 - > Hard to turn (especially going up hills)
 - > Back end squats under groomer weight
 - > Out in the weather
 - > Very little room to carry supplies
 - > Can overheat at low speeds

> 2018 Polaris 570 Sportsman Big Boss

– Pros

- > Narrow so good for narrow trails
- > Better low speed turning than snowmachine
- > Can back out when stuck
- > Back end "floats" well with heavy groomer
- > Room to carry gear
- > Good visibility

- Cons

- > Overheating issues
- > Belt replacement in field sucks!
- > Out in the elements
- > Not good on steep side slopes
- > Sometimes likes to throw a track off

> 2023 Kubota RTV-X1100C

– Pros

- > Can really pull / climb
- > Stops on steep downhills
- > Warm cab
- > Room to carry gear
- > Room in the cab for 2 comfortably

- Cons

- > VERY slow
- > Hard to start cold (does have block heater and battery warmer)
- > Bad on steep side slopes
- > Learning curve for hydrostatic transmission

> 1986 Pisten Bully 160 D

- Pros
 - > Covers a lot of trail in one pass
 - Double classic track pan setters
 - > Hydraulic tiller can really turn up the snow and burry debris
 - > Down pressure on the beaver tail can make a very hard packed trail
 - > 12 way blade
 - > Room for gear or rider but not both
 - > Great visibility for operator and trail users
 - Climbs really well

- Cons

- > Need CDL to take on road
- > Needs to be inside overnight before and after grooming
- > Hard to start when cold
- > Too wide for some of our trails
- > Needs good snow to operate (minimum of 1 foot of compacted snow to groom)
- > OLD!!
