Recreational Trails Program RTP in a nutshell



- Roughly \$1.5 million for trail projects each year
- Bonus Round with applications due April 30th
- Applications due in the fall (Oct/Nov) for upcoming year
- Now is a great time to be thinking about and planning an RTP Grant application for the Fall for 2022!

Alaska Trails RTP Projects

- 2006 - Alaska Trail Steward Training Program: \$31,725
- 2008 - Hillside Single-track: \$50,000
- 2009 - ESTER DOME SINGLETRACK TRAIL: \$50,000
- 2009 - HILLSIDE SINGLETRACK PROJECT, PHASE II: \$50,000
- 2010 - HAPPY VALLEY TRAIL CONSTRUCTION PHASE II: \$50,000
- 2013 - Government Peak Single Track: \$50,000
Tool Trailer: \$18,833
Alaska Trails 2014 Trails Conference: \$32,250
- 2016 - Alaska Trails, Mirror Lake Phase I: \$50,000.00 Alaska Trails and Chugach Mountain Bike Riders
- 2018 - Alaska Trails, Mirror Lake Phase II: \$50,000.00 Alaska Trails / CMBR
- 2019 - Alaska Trails, South Fork Rim Trail: \$59,175.00,
- 2020 - Alaska Trails, Bird to Gird Trail: \$42,339.00

2021 – Something old and something new

- **Contract Brushing at Eklutna Lake** – similar to past years, with the same contractor as Bird to Gird.
- **Little O'Malley Peak Trail** – Funding for our trail crew – which includes a Trail Crew Leader and five crew members. This is new and exciting for Alaska Trails.
